Kindergarten Orientation Puggles Program

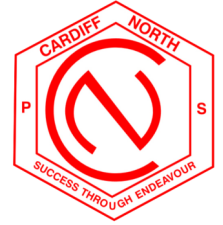

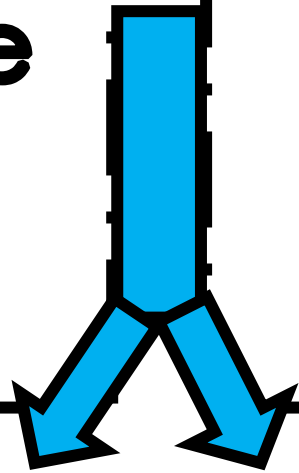
