### Assistant Principal's Message

Welcome to Term 4, I hope everyone has had an enjoyable break with their family and friends. Staff have collaboratively worked together to plan for another great term at Cardiff North. Below is a summary of key organisational structures in place this term:

#### Student Health

Advice regarding student testing for COVID-19 remains the same. If a student has been absent due to flu-like illness or develops flu-like symptoms while at school, they are not to return to school until they have a negative COVID-19 test and are symptom-free. The negative COVID-19 test result must be sighted and received by the school for both students and staff members before their return to school.

#### End of Day Bell Change

Beginning next week, the end of day bell will go back to 3pm. Students will continue to exit from their assigned gates and parents/carers are to wait for their children outside the school grounds. Please continue to remain socially distant from other adults whilst waiting for your child. A staff member will supervise each gate to assist with this process.

#### Kindergarten and Year 7 Transitions

Kindergarten and Year 7 transition programs can now resume with strict guidelines. Once organisation is finalised for these programs, this will be communicated to relevant families.

#### Semester 2 Reports

Semester 2 2020 reporting to parents/carers will include assessment against a 5-point scale (A to E or equivalent) for each subject. The exemption provided to schools for reporting to parents/carers in a modified fashion during the learning from home period in Semester 1 no longer applies. In response to this and feedback received from our remote learning survey, we have revised our regular reporting structure. This structure has been discussed with both staff and P&C and aims to provide clear and individualised reporting of your child's achievement and current learning goals.

#### Scripture

Scripture lessons recommenced today. Scripture classes remain the same as the beginning of the year and organisational structures have been reviewed to ensure they coincide with Term 4 COVID-19 safety guidelines. *continued....*

### Year 6 Farewell

In response to updated COVID guidelines, we are pleased to announce we are now able to plan and implement our annual Year 6 farewell. After careful consideration of the guidelines for school formals and consultation with staff and P&C, we have booked a large function room at Club Macquarie to hold the farewell on Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> December. This organisation is supported by the completion of a COVID-19 Safety Plan and a number of measures have been put in place to ensure the safety and hygiene of all attendees. Unfortunately, our numbers will be too high for Year 5 students to attend as the 4-square-metre rule applies. A detailed information note regarding the farewell was sent home yesterday with Year 6 students.

Information notes went home with Year 5 students this week informing parents and carers applications for Year 7 entry to selective high schools in 2022 are now open. **Applications will close on 16th November 2020**. Parents can apply online at <https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7>

All applicants are required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test to be held on Thursday 11 March 2021.

The department has introduced a new application system that will give parents a more interactive experience. The new system enables parents to make updates and add attachments even after an application is submitted. Parents can also communicate directly with the High Performing Students Team through the system's new 'messages' feature. 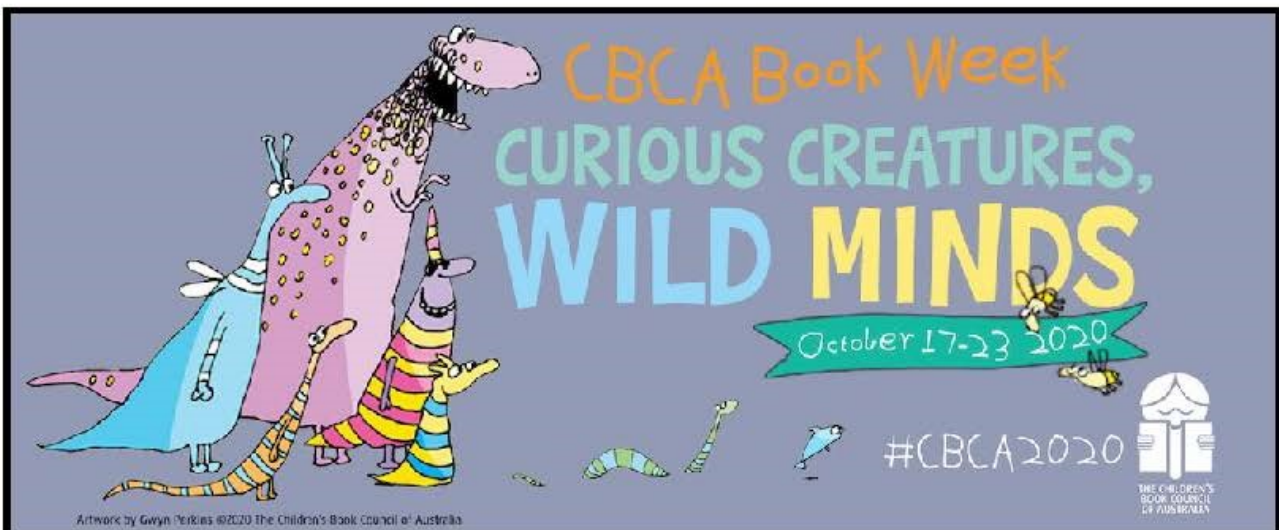
### School Photos

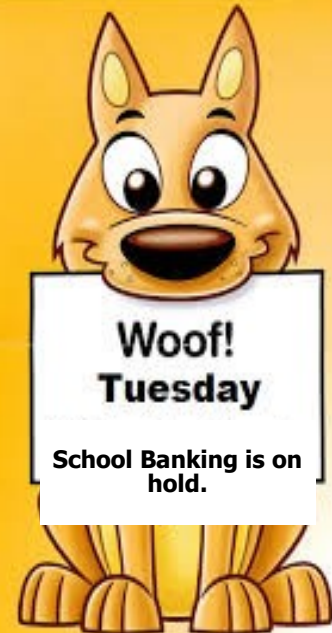
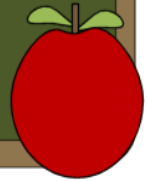

- ❑ The area will be set up in such a way as to ensure that each individual student will maintain the recommended physical distancing guidelines of 1.5m from other students and the photographer.
- ❑ MSP Photography staff will provide instructions to each class upon entry to the photography area.
- ❑ Hygiene and cleaning guidelines used by MSP Photography staff are in accordance with information distributed by the relevant Health Authorities.
